



## Engaged Student Award

### Award Criteria

The Engaged Student Award will celebrate the work of engaging students in service to community, and increasing their sense of social awareness, and perception of service and leadership that enhances the common good. Over the course of her/his student years, the nominee will have demonstrated leadership and active participation in community engaged projects and served as an advocate for community engagement on campus or in institutions.

#### Eligibility

The Engaged Student Award is an individual award in recognition of a student's exceptional contributions to the field of community psychology. Nominees must have:

- At least a Masters qualification
- Demonstrated a sustained commitment to community service throughout their university career
- Exhibited leadership and displayed interest in key civic issues through direct involvement in local communities and provided inspiration to others in the field
- Contributed to critical academic scholarship

#### Assessment Criteria

The nominee's contribution to community psychology and community engaged research should be visible through excellent research, refereed publications, participation in securing research grants, and the national and international visibility of her/his profile and projects.

#### The nomination form below should be submitted with a letter of support detailing:

The nature of the nominee's work, specifying the contribution to community engagement and community psychology:

- Describing why the nominee is deserving of this award by delineating the work done by the nominee over the course of her/his university career, outlining how she/he has engaged with local communities, and made a positive lasting impact on the local community
- Comparing the nominee with others in her/his field

#### Additional Documents Required

Curriculum Vitae of the nominee; letters of support from at least two scholars familiar with the nominee's work; letters of support from at least two community members or organisations that benefited from the nominee's engaged scholarship; at least one peer reviewed article; and one reprint of the nominee's representative work (preferably in electronic format)
